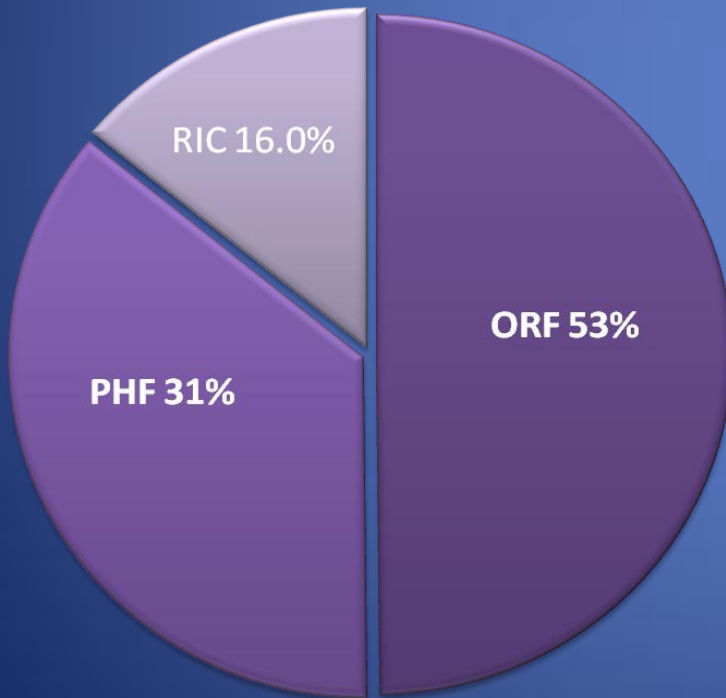

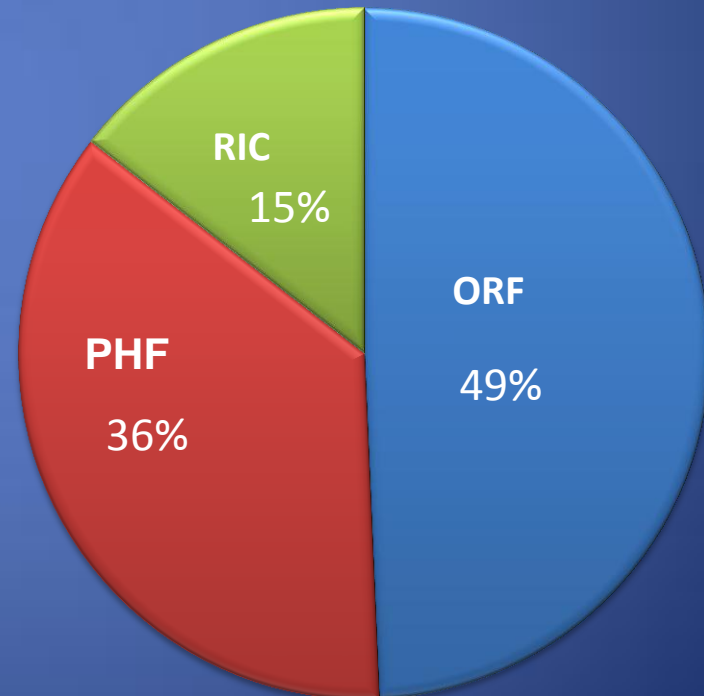

Airports of Origin - Primary Catchment Area

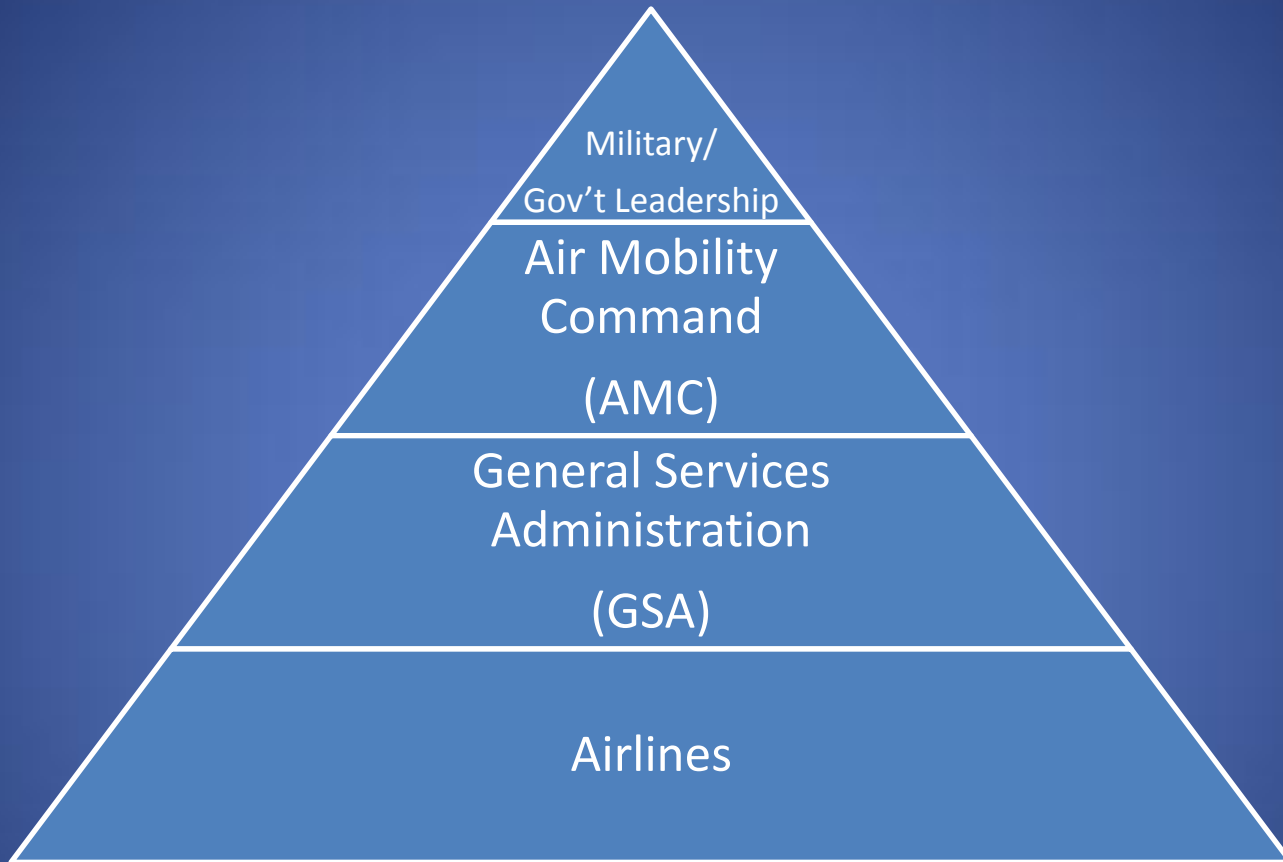
